It was a short and intensive meeting where they could see the real results and also the real problems that could appear during the development of the project.

Firstly they started to read their own

results in each country and to know what were the needs to improve respect the project in the differents countries. In one hand, they could find some problems that could improve in a future of the project, like in Netherlands for example, educators told that they need time to integrate the Badges system to the educational system, as other countries like Spain need too. For some participants, to try this, it was an extra work for them, because of the period when they did it, almost the end of the course, when they were full of activities. In Germany for example the participants said that some Badges are difficult to understand for them. But on the other hand, unemployed citizens and immigrants in differents countries like Italy or Germany they see the Badges competences very interesting.

In conclusion, that was a very gratifying meeting because of all the real results, but also, intensive and hard, they had to give new solutions to the new problems and try to adapt and improve some parts of the project for the future. Follow up the ideas also discused and very soon you will find out more about the results.
